
AFS – 8th meeting of ECR and students' group 25/09/2024

1. Introductions to new members

2. Student presentation (Ms Nur Shafika, student at Universitas Dipenegoro, Indonesia)

Research aim: Understanding the factors influencing migrations of fishers to find better fishing locations, and understanding the transfer of knowledge and technology resulting from the migration.

Ms Shafika identified push and pull factors for migration, including market demands, known fishing resources available, overfishing and lack of opportunities in central, northern Java. One highlight of her research is the importance of the role of migrant fishers in sharing knowledge with other fishers.

3. Presentation skills (Prof. Neil Loneragan)

Tips on presentation skills. It covered the differences between oral and written presentations, the effective use of graphics (e.g., colours, font sizes, etc) as well as images (instead of text).
