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Dr. Wenbo Zhang obtained his PhD degree in aquaculture from the University of Stirling in the UK in 2014. He is currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Aquaculture at the College of Fisheries and Life Science, Shanghai Ocean University. His research focuses on the sustainable development of aquaculture, and he has published high-profile academic papers in journals such as Nature. His H-index is 19 with total citations of 3,400. He serves as a consultant expert for the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations and the Network of Aquaculture Centres in Asia-Pacific (NACA), and is the lead author of the "Aquaculture transformation: Innovation and investment for sustainable intensification and expansion of aquaculture in Asia and the Pacific region," a landmark document for the development of aquaculture in the Asia-Pacific region from 2022 to 2030. Since 2022, he has served as a member of the Chinese delegation to the Fisheries Committee (COFI) and the Subcommittee on Aquaculture (COFI:AQUA) of the FAO. In 2023, he served as the head of the Chinese delegation to the Subcommittee on Aquaculture of FAO's Fisheries Committee and as co-chair of the task force meeting for the finalization of the FAO's "Guidelines for Sustainable Aquaculture."
